Great Basin -- Archaeology

Includes articles, reports, editorials, and other publications on Anthropology and related fields. Produced by the Anthropological Literature Database (from Harvard University) and Anthropological Index (from the UK's Royal Anthropological Institute).

America: History and Life
Covers U.S. & Canadian history, prehistory-present. Includes articles, book reviews, essays, commentaries, bibliographies, news items, abstracts.

JSTOR
A full-text scholarly journal archive, back to vol. 1, issue 1, in many fields.

Google Scholar
Google's search engine for scholarly literature. See also Google Search Tab.
